July is going to be busy month, so be sure to read on!!!

Round Clock:



As you may recall or have heard, J's Bridge Pad recently added a TV. I know what you are thinking. Can we watch Cardinal games on it? Unfortunately not, but we do have big plans for its use to to enhance your brige playing experience. One of the ways which have already begun to utilize it has been to use to it as our Round Clock during game play. Below are a couple of notes and tips regarding the Round Clock to help you use it to your advantage.

- We have started using the Round Clock in all games when appropriate. Intially, we will use the Round Clock in Intermediate /Novice games for training purposes.
- Be sure to keep an eye on the clock so that you can keep pace.
- You are allowed 7 minutes per board. The Round clock starts counting down from the total round time. For example, if it is a 3 board round, the round clock will start at at 21 minutes and then count down. It will also give you time for a 1 minute break between rounds to move to the next table.
- The Round Clock will also give a 2 minute warning. When the two minute warning sounds you cannot start a new board and should finish the board as quickly as possible. Boards that are not played will be scored as "No Play". If you want to know what that means, please ask. me.

Various warning sounds are available, we will try out some and will end up using the one you like! There is also a beginning of a new round warning.

Proudly represent J's Bridge Pad and save 2 bucks at the same time!




Monthly Attendance Prizes:



Diamond Card:

Did you know that the diamond card is good for 365 days from the date that you buy it? Just as a reminder for those of you who don't know, the Diamond Card saves you \$2 a game for every game you play at J's Bridge Pad for 365 days from the date of purchase. Its cost is \$30. Regardless of when you buy it, you get one year of savings. For example, if you bought it in June 2019, you would play games at J's Bridge Pad for a discount of \$2 a game till the end of June 2020. If you play in 15

or more games, during that period, the card pays for itself! Think about it, it makes cents, no pun intended.
