## Veteran's Day, November 11th:

This Veteran's day we would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge J's Bridge Pad's good friend Dave Peterson, Pictured below.

On July 1, 1944 Dave entered the V12, a collegiate officer training program, and was then sent to Boot Camp. He joined the Navy in 1945 was sent to the USS Mississippi which was in Norfolk, VA for repairs. He was transferred to the USS Dayton which was in the Caribbean. Subsequently, Dave entered the Air Force as a 2nd Lieutenant during the Korean Conflict in 1951 and served until 1953. While in the Air Force he spent 1 year in Japan and 1 week in Korea. Upon leaving the Air Force he returned to college and studied structural design. While in the Air Force Reserves, he worked on restoring airplanes that would have been scrapped.

Dave, always being modest says, "I was no hero". In my book anyone who serves our country and did as much as him, is a hero.

## Diamond Card Renewal - the 400 Special:
